

Director: Andrew Cockcroft-Penman

Following his studies in Theatre and Performance at the University of New England, Andrew's directing credits span musical theatre, cabaret, and Shakespeare. Notable productions include Savoyards' *Come From Away* ('A Favourite Director of 2025' Theatre Haus; 'A Favourite Production of 2025' Theatre Haus; 'Audience Choice Award for Best Production 2025' Stage Buzz Brisbane; 'Best Musical of 2025' Blue Curtains), *Little Shop of Horrors* and *The Wizard of Oz* (Players Theatre Co), *Kiss Me, Kate!* (Gold Coast Little Theatre), *The Popular Mechanicals*, *Woyzeck*, and *Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street* (University of New England), *Curtains* (Beenleigh Theatre Group), *The Government Inspector* (Javeenbah Theatre), and *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, *Oliver!*, and *The Mystery of Edwin Drood* (Spotlight Theatrical Company). In addition to directing, Andrew is an award-winning designer and choreographer, receiving two Dolphin Awards and a Special President's Award for his service to Gold Coast Little Theatre. Since founding Technicolour Theatre Company in 2018, he has led the company to national recognition with acclaimed productions including *Peter Pan*, *Godspell*, *Romeo and Juliet*, the Australian premiere of Chichester Festival Youth Theatre's *Pinocchio*, and the inaugural Gold Coast *Shakespeare in the Park* production of *A Midsummer Night's Dream*. In 2023, Andrew partnered with Undercover Artist Festival, in collaboration with Queensland Theatre and Brisbane Festival, to develop and premiere *Sleep and the City* by Emma-June Curik at Bille Brown Theatre.

Sally Faint is a dedicated musical director, educator, and performer with over 17 years of experience across musical theatre and music education. She holds a Bachelor of Music and a Graduate Diploma of Teaching and is passionate about supporting both school and community productions through strong musicianship and collaborative leadership. Adelle came to theatre rather unintentionally while completing a Bachelor of Creative Arts in Film and Television in what she lovingly calls her mid-life crisis years. Since her first foray into theatre as assistant stage manager in Mt. Cotton Drama Groups 2017, *Lend Me a Tenor*, her love of all things theatre and directing has steadily grown. Most recently Adelle has directed *Cliffnotes of Insanity: A Princess Bride Parody* (Brisbane Arts Theatre), *The Appleton Ladies Potato Race*, *Murder on the Menu*, *Farmer Will Swap Combine Harvester for Wife*, and *Swingers* (MATES Theatre Genesis). Adelle joined Savoyards for the first time in 2025 as dialect coach and Newfoundland Cultural Consultant for *Come From Away*. She is looking forward to being a part of the team again as Assistant Director for *Sister Act*.



Assistant Choreographer: Wallis Nersesian

Originally from Las Vegas, Wallis began her dance training at age three. She is an alumnus of the Las Vegas Academy of the Arts and holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance from California Institute of the Arts (CalArts), where she focused heavily on contemporary dance and choreography. After graduation, Wallis pivoted to musical theatre, performing for several seasons with Super Summer Theatre and working as a commercial dancer and dance teacher in Las Vegas. Since moving to the Brisbane Bayside, Wallis has loved returning to the stage with Savoyards, performing in *42nd Street* (2023) and *Curtains* (2024). Wallis currently shares her love of dance as a teacher at Bayside Dance in Wynnum and is excited to bring that energy and passion to the *Sister Act* team and cast.

About Savoyards

Savoyards is the oldest continuously running musical theatre company in Brisbane. From our first performance of *The Mikado* in November 1961 to our most recent productions, Savoyards has produced at least two major musical theatre shows every year, receiving 15 Del Artè Charts recognitions for everything from costume and set design, choreography, venue, and musical theatre production to direction. We are a community based (amateur) company governed and managed completely by volunteers and we enjoy the generosity of many professionals who offer their services at little or no cost simply to encourage theatre in Brisbane. These professionals provide us with expertise in management, marketing, hair, and makeup, set construction, photography and much more. We perform in the luxurious theatre of the Iona Performing Arts Complex, 85 North Road, Lindum. To give a well-rounded experience of theatre to our performers we encourage all performers to become active in other aspects of the Society, and while it is not compulsory to become a financial member of the Society to participate, we would also encourage you to consider this and therefore play a part in shaping and ensuring the future of Savoyards.

Savoyards is a community-based society run by volunteers and as such it is an expectation that all members of the cast and crew will help in a variety of ways throughout the production of Sister Act. This includes assisting with backstage aspects of the show such as helping at bump-in and bump-out of the theatre.

About Sister Act

Sister Act is the feel-good musical comedy smash based on the hit 1992 film starring Whoopi Goldberg, guaranteed to have audiences rejoicing. Featuring original music by Tony Award– and eight-time Oscar winner Alan Menken (*Aladdin*, *Beauty and the Beast*, *Little Shop of Horrors*), this uplifting production was nominated for five Tony Awards, including Best Musical.

When disco diva Deloris Van Cartier witnesses a murder, she is placed in protective custody in the one place the police are certain she won't be found: a convent. Disguised as a nun, Deloris clashes with the rigid lifestyle and the formidable Mother Superior. Using her extraordinary vocal talent and unmistakable disco flair, she transforms the struggling choir and breathes new life into the church and its community—until her rising profile threatens to expose her identity. With the gang closing in, Deloris and her newfound sisterhood must band together in a joyous celebration of courage, connection, and empowerment.

Rooted in 1970s disco and classical musical theatre styles, the choreography for *Sister Act* emphasises groove, character, and joyful ensemble storytelling. The nuns form a major ensemble presence and may also appear throughout the show as additional characters. Male-presenting roles are also required to dance, with choreography tailored to a range of abilities while still highlighting confident, coordinated performers. Stronger dancers will have ample opportunities to be showcased.

Filled with powerful gospel music, exuberant dancing, and a truly moving story, *Sister Act* is a sparkling tribute to the universal power of friendship. Savoyards is delighted to present the Queensland Community Theatre Premiere of this divine musical comedy.



ALL CHARACTERS MUST PRESENT A PRINCIPAL AUDITION

Deloris Van Cartier

An aspiring performer searching for recognition, self-determination, and community. When she is forced into hiding at the convent, she initially resists its rules and structure, but through her work with the choir she finds purpose, community, and leadership. Charismatic, confident, and emotionally generous, Deloris brings contemporary musicality that transforms the convent and its people.

We are committed to inclusive and respectful casting and welcome performers of all backgrounds, identities and experiences to audition. For the role of Deloris in particular — a character written as a Black woman — we especially encourage performers who identify as Black, First Nations Australian, or part of the African diaspora to audition.

Gender: female presenting Age: 21 to 40 Vocal range: F3 - F5

Mother Superior

The head of the convent. Highly principled, guarded, and deeply committed to protecting the sisters from external influence. Her firm leadership style places her in direct conflict with Deloris, particularly regarding the role of music and engagement with the outside world. Beneath her rigidity is a profound sense of responsibility and care.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: female presenting Age: 50 to 70 Vocal range: D3 - D5

Sister Mary Robert

A postulant who was abandoned as a baby and raised at the convent. Reserved and introspective, she struggles with self-confidence and visibility. Through Deloris' mentorship and the choir, she discovers personal agency and expressive power, culminating in a profound transformation.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: female presenting Age: 18 to 25 Vocal range: F#3 - G5

Sister Mary Patrick

A nun of the convent whose outward energy and enthusiasm are constant. Joyful, impulsive, and wholehearted, she approaches convent life—and music—with uninhibited commitment and delight.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: female presenting Age: 35 to 50 Vocal range: G3 – E6

Sister Mary Lazarus

A long-standing nun and the head of the choir. Initially resistant to change and sceptical of Deloris' influence, she values tradition and discipline. Over time, she reconnects with musical passion and adaptability through exposure to new styles and perspectives.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: female presenting Age: 50 to 70 Vocal range: E3 – C5

Monsignor O'Hara

One of the senior leaders of the convent. Pragmatic and focused on financial sustainability, he is often concerned with public perception and fundraising. Despite this, he proves surprisingly open to the positive impact of the choir's musical evolution.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: male presenting

Age: 45 to 60

Vocal range: F3 - G4

Curtis

Antagonist. A nightclub owner and organised crime figure, as well as Deloris' romantic partner. Image-conscious, controlling, and volatile, he uses charm as a means of exerting power and intimidation. His instability poses a real and escalating threat.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: male presenting

Age: 30 to 40

Vocal range: A2 - Ab4

Eddie Souther

A desk officer at the Philadelphia police station and a former high school classmate of Deloris. Earnest, anxious under pressure, and deeply idealistic, Eddie longs to prove his worth—both professionally and personally. His affection for Deloris fuels his desire to be courageous and heroic.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: male presenting

Age: 21 to 40

Vocal range: Ab2 - B4

TJ

Curtis' nephew and one of his associates. Self-assured and highly aware of his own appeal, he moves through the world with confidence and a lack of self-reflection, rarely questioning consequences.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: male presenting

Age: 18 to 30

Vocal range: Db3 - Eb5

Joey

One of Curtis' associates. Outwardly smooth and performative, he is invested in projecting confidence and desirability, particularly in his interactions with women.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: male presenting

Age: 30 to 40

Vocal range: Bb2 - Eb5

Pablo

One of Curtis' associates. Quietly observant and loyal, he often follows the lead of others. He primarily communicates in Spanish, which adds texture and rhythm to group dynamics.

This role requires speaking in Spanish, either fluently or with strong proficiency. Performers with lived experience of Spanish-speaking culture are strongly encouraged to audition.

Age: 25 to 40

Vocal range top: C4 - F5

Sister Mary Martin-of-Tours

A nun of the convent who appears detached from her surroundings. While often seemingly lost in her own thoughts, she occasionally offers moments of unexpected insight and clarity.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: female presenting

Age: 40 to 60

Sister Mary Theresa

The eldest nun of the convent. Physically frail in appearance but mentally sharp and resilient, she frequently subverts expectations with her toughness and resolve.

This role can be played by a person of any ethnicity.

Gender: female presenting

Age: 60 to 70

Ensemble (10 Female and 3 male roles)

Ensemble members will typically portray multiple roles across different settings and may also serve as covers where indicated. Ensemble tracks are subject to adjustment based on casting, staging, and production needs. These roles can be played by a performer of any ethnicity.

The ensemble includes three male-presenting and four female-presenting characters with stronger dance skills who will be featured in more demanding dance material throughout the show.
